David Erickson

Professor emeritus of art at Indiana State University, Erickson taught printmaking, papermaking and drawing for more than three decades. In addition, he exhibits his work locally, nationally and internationally, and is active within the community with theater set designs as well as large-scale murals and tile mosaics. He is acknowledged as a major contributor to the growth of handmade papermaking in America.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to Indiana and Illinois artists age 18 years and older. Art must be original, completed within the last three (3) years and not previously exhibited in a RCAA show.

2D entries must be installation-ready with hanging wire on the back; no sawtooth hooks. Gallery-wrapped canvas paintings or photographs will be accepted. RCAA reserves the right to reject work that is not ready to hang. Please bring easels (floor or table easels; or open grid display panels allowed) to display your work.
